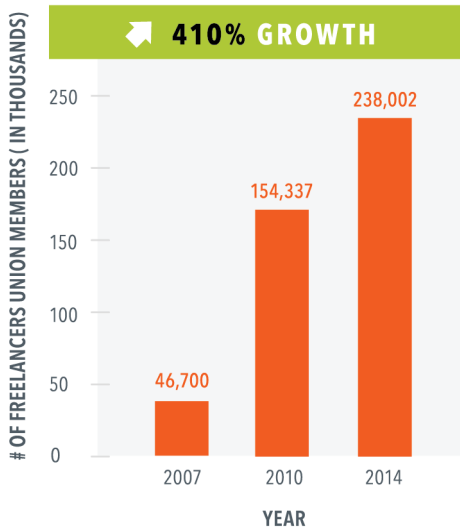
THE NUMBERS BEHIND THE NEW WORKFORCE

What did we learn? Freelancers are younger. Freelancers are everywhere. Freelancers do everything. And every day, the freelance movement is growing.

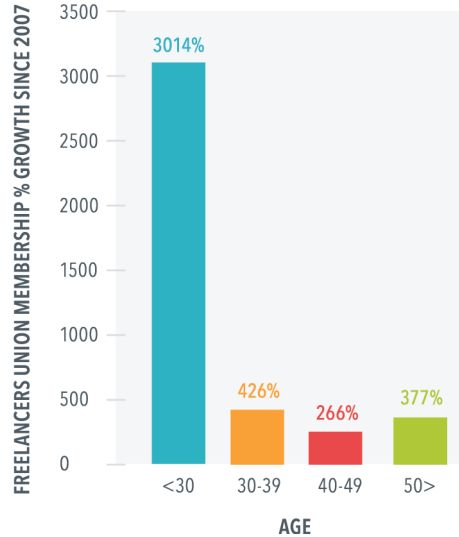
Freelancers Union has major people power.

For Millennials, freelancing is the new normal.

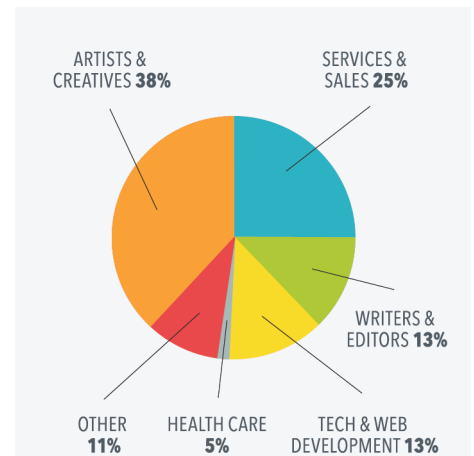

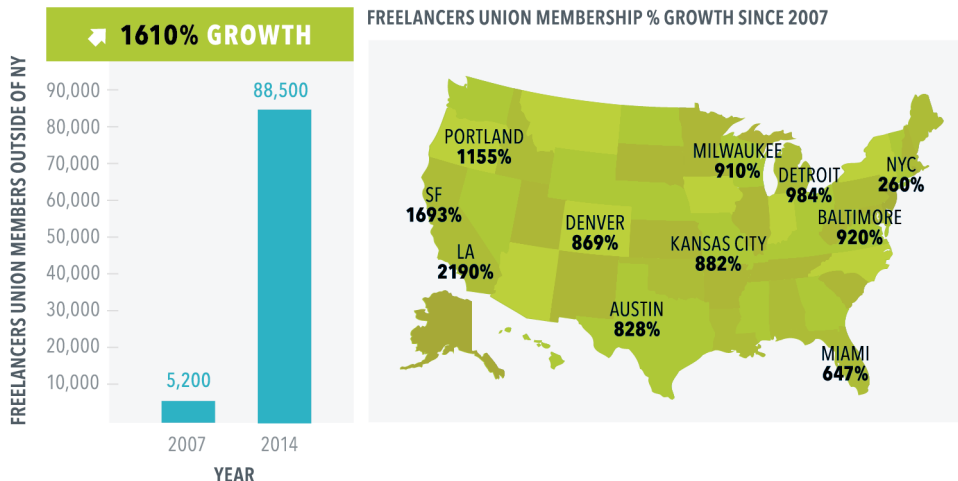
